\$10 million is in an escrow account controlled by the Board of Public Works (BPW). The money can only be used for "meets standards" PMP ratings and will be a onetime bonus only. It cannot be tied to base salary. The BPW will decide in September 2002 if the USM can use the money for merit increases. If allowed, the money will not be available until January 1, 2003. It is predicted that the increment will be 1.25%.
